



GUIDELINES FOR ARTICLES

Articles are generally a maximum of 1600 words, with a maximum of six figures (photos, diagrams, charts, maps, etc.). However, we realize that some topics require more content. Please contact me if you are going to exceed the maximums so I can plan accordingly.

PLEASE INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

1. The author's name, title and credentials, and company name, as you want it to appear in the magazine.
2. Any references used (report format). Please include a reference section at the end of the article if references are cited in the text.
3. Captions for photographs, diagrams, charts, maps etc.
4. If you are submitting photographs or other graphics from sources other than yourself, **PLEASE** reference the person they belong to in the caption.

ARTICLES CAN BE ON A WIDE

VARIETY OF RECLAMATION TOPICS:

1. A project that has been completed, that is in progress, or that is in the planning stage.
2. Research.
3. A new product.
4. Any other topic relating to reclamation, in any field.

Please note: Articles must pertain to reclamation and focus on the topic, not on the promotion of a person(s) or a company.

FORMATTING:

1. Text **ONLY** in Microsoft Word
2. **NO TRACK CHANGES** if sending revised copies. Please highlight changed areas or colour the font. There is a problem between the Microsoft software and the publishing software when track changes are used.
3. **NO** images should be imbedded in the Word document as they cannot be published in this format.

IMAGES (PHOTOGRAPHS, CHARTS, DRAWINGS, GRAPHS, LOGOS):

1. Electronic images – guidelines:
 - Images must be 500kb or larger. We will work with size as per design requirements. Larger images will remain clear when made smaller, but small images will become blurry when made larger.
 - Images must be 300 dpi.
 - All graphics must be submitted as either a high resolution *.tif or *.jpg. Please **DO NOT** compress your files.
2. Original photographs are accepted (will be returned).
3. Images copied from a website or off the internet will **NOT** be accepted as they do not have the resolution and quality required for print production.
4. We **DO NOT** accept powerpoint slides or images embedded into Word or Excel.

Images that are not cited in the text as a figure will be placed randomly throughout the article by the designer.

If an image does not meet the quality standard of the magazine, I will contact you to discuss alternatives. We reserve the right not to publish a poor quality image.
